

Array AG/VxAG is Vulnerable to Command Injection Attacks

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Vulnerability

For AG and vxAG, AG 9.4.0.499 and all earlier versions are vulnerable to command injection attacks. Attackers can construct specially formatted packets to run commands remotely. AG and vxAG 9.3.0.259.x are not affected.

Workarounds

There are two ways to avoid this vulnerability:

• Turn off the MotionPro service using the following command. We suggest you use this workaround.

CMD(config)# vpn motionpro off



Note: The following versions of the MotionPro client can run properly even if this service is off:

Windows 1.2.21, MacOS 1.2.18, Linux 1.2.16, Android 3.0.24, iOS 2.0.22, and later versions.

• When the filter in a virtual site is turned on, you can use URL filter to disable MotionPro to avoid this vulnerability.

Prerequisite:

CMD(config)# filter on

Add the configuration:

CMD(config)# filter url keyword deny motionpro
